HIT-08 TRIPLE FAST ACTION "Ronnie's Pants" B/W "Aerosmith" [SEVEN-INCH]

A brand new single from Triple Fast Action, the records are finally here!!! "Ronnie's Pants" is straight ahead pop, of the triple fast variety; "Aerosmith" is the bands' sweetly emotional tribute to the masters.

HIT-05 SARDINA "Me and My Arrow" B/W "Fool for Your Love #9" [SEVEN-INCH]

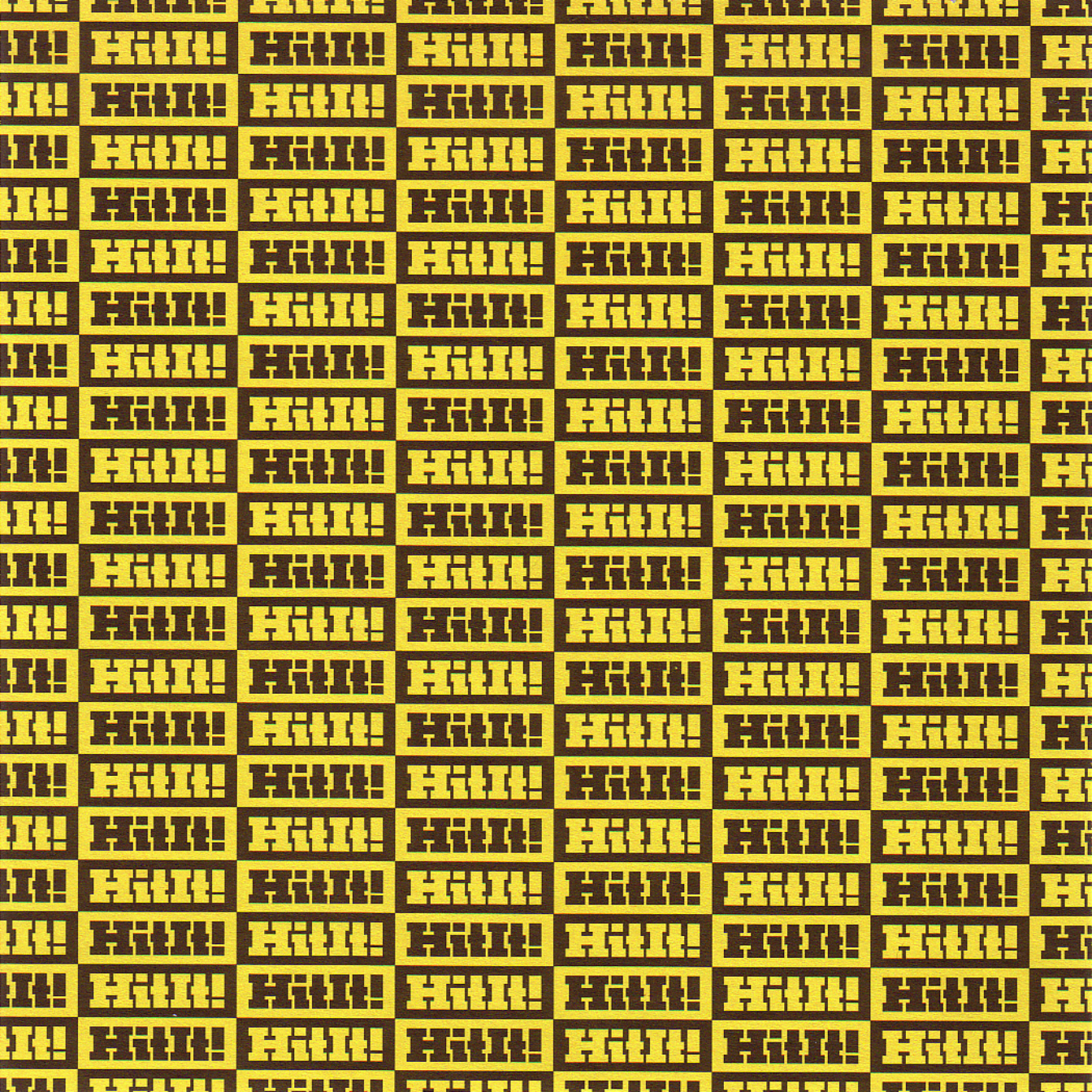
